

PLANNED PARENTHOOD AND RIVALS IN ILLINOIS – CRUISING FOR A MANN ACT BRUISING?

PLANNED PARENTHOOD – BABY BUTCHER OF THE HEARTLAND?

Illinois is the No. 1 state in the Union for abortion tourism. In 2024, per the Guttmacher Institute, abortionists did 35,000 or so abortions in Illinois on out-of-state females, about 1/4 of all border-crossing abortions done nationwide. They did about 40% of all abortions on out-of-state females.

Planned Parenthood officials opened a facility in Carbondale, Illinois in December 2023 for abortion tourism. Planned Parenthood say their abortion customers come mostly from nearby Kentucky and Missouri, but they also attract abortion seekers from southern states. Carbondale is within a four-hour drive of Louisville, Nashville, and Memphis. It is about 100 miles southeast of St. Louis, and about 100 miles west of Evansville, IN.

Amanda Vinicky, in a 6/10/2024 story titled “Vast Majority of Patients at Planned Parenthood of Illinois’ Newest Clinic in Carbondale Come From Out of State” for WTTW-TV, the PBS station in Chicago, wrote the following:

“It’s been about six months since Planned Parenthood of Illinois opened its newest Illinois clinic in Carbondale, home to the main campus of Southern Illinois University. In that time, the overwhelming majority of those getting care at that clinic haven’t lived in Illinois.

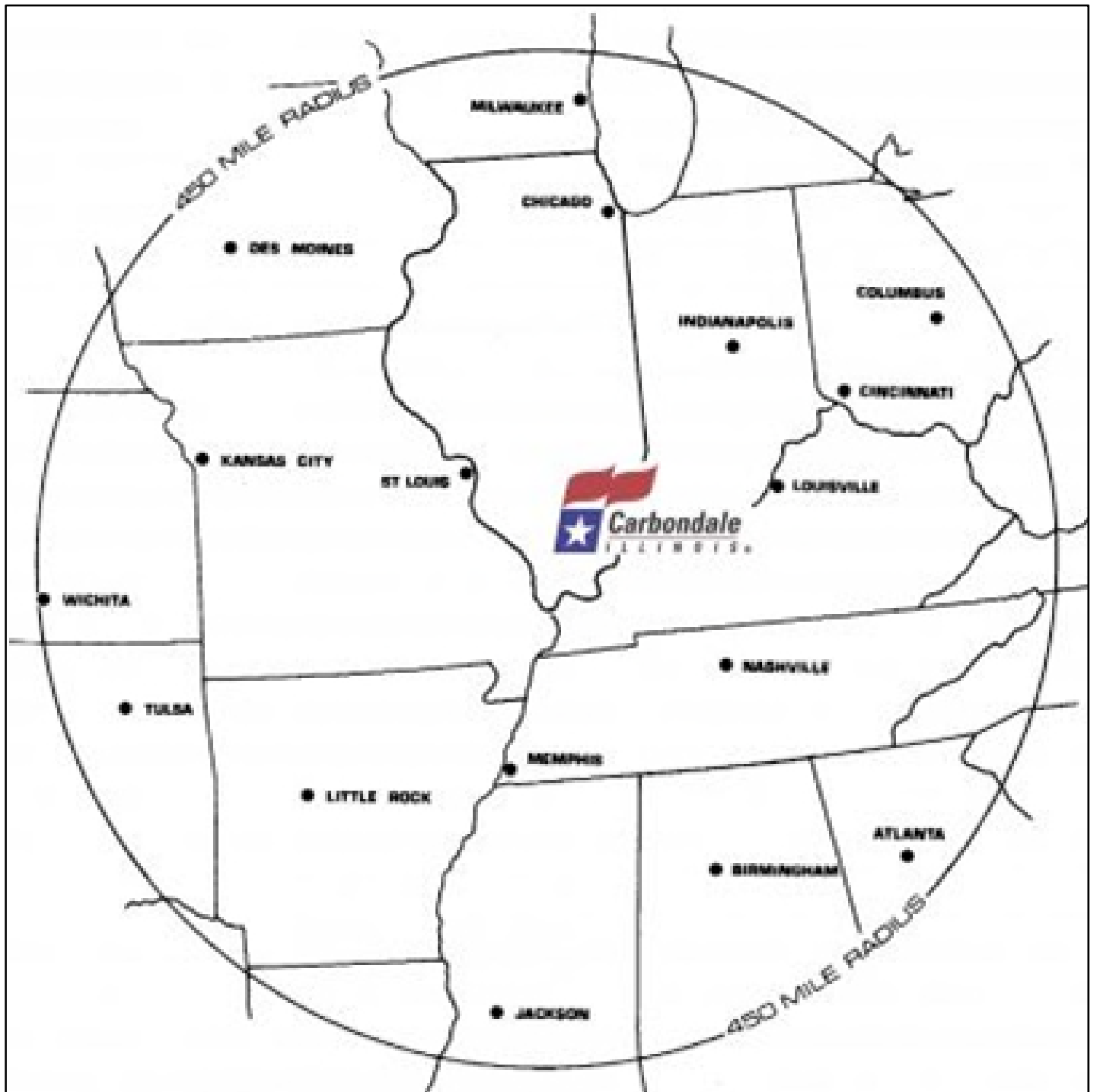
Three-quarters of the patients served by the Carbondale clinic have come from out of state, the organization (Planned Parenthood of Illinois) said in numbers released Monday. Of those out of state patients, 88% reside in states where abortion access is restricted, including Tennessee, Kentucky, Indiana and Missouri.

“We looked at the map and we knew that it was the best possible town in southern Illinois to serve the whole southern Illinois community, and it also is a great location for the surrounding states — none of which have access to abortion,” Jennifer Welch, CEO of Planned Parenthood of Illinois, told WTTW when the center opened. “It’s relatively easy to get to for our neighbors in Kentucky and Tennessee, and it even has a direct train line from New Orleans.”

Comment: La Welch is right. Carbondale is a stop on the “City of New Orleans” Amtrak passenger train line between New Orleans and Chicago. This is sadly appropriate. Trains have carried livestock to slaughter yards for generations. They also carried people unwanted by Hitler to extermination camps in Nazi-controlled Europe. Even before the U.S. Supreme Court’s 2022 Dobbs decision that overturned Roe’s national abortion protections, the organization purposefully built or staffed up clinics along Illinois’ border.

A clinic in south suburban Flossmoor, some 13 miles from Munster, Indiana, opened in 2018; a clinic in Waukegan, less than 10 miles from the Wisconsin state line, opened in 2020; and the clinic in the college community of Champaign, roughly an hour from the Indiana border, expanded in 2022. That year, Planned Parenthood also moved its Chicago Loop health center to a larger location.

Planned Parenthood also said it expanded a program that sends abortion pills by mail and advocated for a 2023 law that allows advanced practice nurses to perform abortions that don't require anesthesia."



Carbondale, Illinois booster drawing makes Planned Parenthood leader Jennifer Welch's point. The little college town on the City of New Orleans route to Chicago from the Lower Mississippi Valley is well-positioned to host the Baby Butchers of the Heart of America.

Another WTTW-TV writer, Eunice Alpasan, reported the following 4/17/2025:

“In 2024, nearly a quarter of all out-of-state abortions took place in Illinois, as the total number of abortions in the state slightly decreased compared to the previous year, according to a recent study by a pro-abortion rights research policy organization.

On a national level, the study found a less than 1% increase in the number of people obtaining an abortion from 2023 to 2024, according to estimates from the Guttmacher Institute, which looked at states without total abortion bans. However, the number of people in the U.S. who crossed state lines for an abortion dropped by nearly 9%.

About 35,000 out-of-state patients traveled to Illinois for an abortion last year, accounting for 39% of all abortions provided in the state, according to the study. Illinois saw a 7% decrease in the number of patients traveling from out of state for an abortion.”

COMMENT: This is likely because Ohio officials started allowing more abortions in 2024.

“Overall, there was an estimated total of 89,770 abortions in Illinois last year, a 1% decrease from the previous year, according to the study’s estimates.

The Guttmacher Institute study, based on a monthly survey of providers, is the latest look at how the abortion landscape in the U.S. has evolved since the U.S. Supreme Court reversed Roe v. Wade in 2022. The ruling eliminated the constitutional right to abortion, opening the door to state bans and restrictions.

Illinois continues to serve more out-of-state abortion patients than any other state. The study points to the state’s geographic location and the efforts of state government, abortion providers and support organizations that create a robust infrastructure for abortion care, allowing it to be an access point for the South and Midwest,” Eunice ejaculated.

Planned Parenthood personnel could merit Mann Act investigation for possibly aiding in the criminal coverup of sexual abusers of underage girls being brought across state lines for abortions, birth control, or VD treatments.

Carbondale’s local political leaders, perhaps thinking of their popularity with the staff and faculty and student body of Southern Illinois University, and the boost in business to local gas stations, fast food joints, cheap motels, and liquor stores (and the associated tax revenue jump), welcomed Planned Parenthood and their rival abortionists into town. In the spirit of the Chicagoland politicians who protected Al Capone’s gang and his successors in the Outfit for decades, town politicians enacted laws severely limiting protest outside abortion facilities. Planned Parenthood abortionist and official Colleen McNicholas, whose slovenly health standards led Missouri authorities to shut down the abortion facility in Columbia she ran, had this to say about her abortionist experience at the Planned Parenthood facility in Fairview Heights, per an article written by AP reporter Amanda Seitz 3/25/2023:

“Most patients coming to the Fairview Heights clinic are no longer from the region, either. During the final six months of last year, the clinic saw 2,042 abortion patients from outside of Missouri or Illinois — up from just 314 the six months before.

Women are now seeking abortions later in their pregnancies at the Planned Parenthood clinic, which offers the procedure through 26 weeks. About one-quarter of patients need a second trimester abortion, McNicholas said.

But the hardest change to deal with has been the steady increase in children who are coming to the clinic, hoping to end a pregnancy that was the result of a rape or abuse.

“What you use to see was maybe one or two 10-and 11-year-olds a year,” she said. “Now you’re seeing a couple a month because they’re coming from all over the country. Just sitting with that knowledge that this many people are experiencing so much trauma ... There are times where it’s really hard.”

Colleen McNicholas hasn’t evidently been reporting these children to Illinois authorities. Have Planned Parenthood staffers been reporting out-of-state children to authorities in Illinois or the states they live in? If not, these are likely Mann Act violations on their parts.

Congressman James Mann and other reformers designed the Mann Act to combat sex trafficking of naïve female immigrants and American girls and young women coming from the farms to the cities during the Ellis Island Era. The Mann Act is a has gotten retooling in the past few decades to make it relevant and effective today. Its most recent public successful use was in the 2025 Sean Combs trial. George Soros associate Howie Rubin has been indicted in late 2025 on interstate sex trafficking charges.

PLANNED PARENTHOOD RIVALS HAVE SIMILAR MOTIVATION

What makes an abortionist stop killing babies? A gal who is short on cash or a credit card balance to cover the up-front cost of an abortion.

Planned Parenthood joined two other abortion facility operators in Carbondale, Illinois, a left-leaning Southern Illinois college town. Their rivals had been operating abortion facilities in Tennessee (Choices) and in Texas (Alamo) before those states' leaders decided to outlaw most abortions.

Alamo Women's Clinic of Illinois businesswomen, per their website, only allow cash or credit card payments, the cardholder has to be present at the abortion facility, and the credit card has to transfer money before their people do any abortion work on a woman or girl. Note that the abortion provider asks for a patient-provided "medical history" but doesn't apparently have the woman undergo a physical exam that would verify she is pregnant, is not ectopically pregnant, whether or not she is Rh negative, and whether any medications or surgeries the facility staffers provide are possibly going to harm her.

Such services are not "excessive regulation" – they are part of basic medical care for women and girls.

A legitimate medical operation would allow some sort of billing and payment plan, and insurance reimbursement for those whose insurance covers elective abortions.

COMMENT: Note the "Patient Information" form. On the "WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE SERVICE" paragraph, the corporate types apparently are only worried the woman or girl undergoing the abortion is sober enough to consent. They don't say they will refuse service if the woman or girl is physically or emotionally unable to undergo an abortion.

COMMENT: Note the "Patient Information" form. How in Hell does a "he/him" get pregnant for an abortion?

Brionna M. This woman, a resident of Tennessee, sued Alamo Women's Clinic of Illinois and Samantha Heywood. Brionna charged Ms. Heywood botched an abortion she performed on her in June 2025 so completely that she suffered permanent damage, lost income, and was rendered liable for large medical expenses.

Brionna charged Ms. Heywood aka Ms. Schmidt failed to take a proper medical history on her before attempting the abortion. Brionna said Ms. Heywood aka Ms. Schmidt performed the abortion in "an outpatient setting" (polite legalese for a glorified low-rent doctor office like Alamo) when the surgery was contraindicated. This implies maybe Ms. Sam should have done it in a hospital, where there were real doctors with real skills and access to proper medical equipment and medicines to save her life if the abortionist bungled the surgery. Or maybe this implies Samantha should not have attempted the abortion on Brionna at all.

Hospitals by and large are not in the abortion on demand trade for obvious reasons. Abortion is the medical equivalent of a strip joint, a business that is scorned by many. Also, abortion businesses' staffers and clientele tend to be objectively disordered. For example, the publisher has documented how often Planned Parenthood's customers bring problems with them, like domestic violence, substance abuse, instability and mental problems that lead to police having to take them away, lewd behavior, and threatening or beating their daughters or girlfriends when they try to avoid undergoing abortions. And occasional justifiable anger over being cheated or mistreated. He has also documented staffers of an abortion facility like a Planned Parenthood, like those who work at a strip joint, tend to have more problems – low professional standards, money problems, addiction, personal life issues, racism and prejudice against darker and lower-income people, and the emotions of dealing with working in a business that is reviled by many and is looked down upon by others in the medical field.

What is Samantha Heywood's background? Samantha graduated from the University of Illinois in 2017, but did not have an active physician and surgeon license until mid-2022. She was also listed as Samantha Lee Schmidt, and Samantha Lee Heywood. Samantha's listed specialty is "complex family planning OB-GYN" and she has been listed as a co-author on the treatise "Desire for and barriers to obtaining effective contraception among women experiencing homelessness – PubMed" in 2020. In slightly more than three years, working on healthy, compliant, something-to-hide cash or paid credit card clients coming from out of state, she still managed to get sued.
